

Scholarships, awards and grants 2026-2027

Blanquerna - Ramon Llull University allocates nearly **€1,800,000** to scholarships, awards, and financial aid for students beginning or continuing their studies in any of the three Schools.

Academic Excellence Award

The academic excellence awards provide a **50%** waiver on the tuition and enrollment fees for the academic year in official degree programs. If academic excellence is maintained, the award extends to subsequent years until the student completes the degree they are pursuing.

All students from **Batxillerat** (the Spanish/Catalan pre-university diploma) with a minimum average grade of **8.5**, and students from **FP2, MP3, or CFGS** (vocational training degrees) with a minimum average grade of **9** who are entering university for the first time are eligible to apply free of charge. A specific test must be taken for each intended course of study. For candidates in the Medicine degree, the exam taken into account is the one from the admissions process.

Sports Excellence Award

At Blanquerna, we reward the best sporting talent. The sporting excellence awards provide a **50%** waiver on the tuition and enrollment fees for the academic year in official degree programs. If academic excellence is maintained, the award extends to subsequent years until the student completes the degree they are pursuing.

It can be requested free of charge by all students who can prove they are currently registered with a sports federation, have an average grade of **7** from **Batxillerat** or **8.5** from **CFGS**, are entering university for the first time, and have achieved one of the following results in the last two seasons: **International podium in individual sports** | **Podium in the Spanish Junior Championship (U18)** | **Federation membership in the highest national category for the last two seasons.**

Blanquerna Grants

As a non-profit foundation, Blanquerna seeks to ensure access to high-quality education for the largest possible number of students. Blanquerna-URL grants range from 10% to 90% of the bachelor's degree cost for students facing economic difficulties, also taking into account the academic record from their prior studies.

The **economic income of each member of the family unit** must not exceed €17,000 (the sum of the total gross income of the family unit across all its members).

The academic record from the access studies to university



Submission of an application for the public scholarship from the Ministerio de Educación y Formación Profesional or AGAUR



Special family unit circumstances

Can I find out if I will be granted the Aid before enrolling?

Yes, the application can be submitted before you enroll. You simply need to have formalized the application for a place. Within fifteen days of the interview and submission of documents, the student will be informed of the decision regarding the Aid.

Blanquerna Foundation Discounts (not cumulative with each other)

- Student member of a Large or Single-Parent Family: **5% discount**
- Student with a disability of 33% or more: **5% discount**
- Blanquerna relatives (for a child, sibling, or partner of an alumnus/a or student): **5% discount**

Extracurricular internship program

The **extracurricular internship program** allows students to undertake training activities in various School departments. For selected students, the program guarantees that a significant portion of their annual study costs will be covered. They are announced at the beginning of each academic year.

Job bank for students

The student **job bank** manages temporary or part-time jobs that are compatible with students' class schedules. They are accessible through the intranet from the moment enrollment is completed.

Blanquerna international mobility aid

International mobility aid allows students to participate in an international stay. This is an action funded by Blanquerna to promote the international dimension. This aid is announced by each School within the framework of their respective international programs and projects.

There are three types of aid:

Short stay (not less than five days) - Maximum amount €1,500

Long stay (not less than three months) - Maximum amount €3,000

Students with an Erasmus scholarship - Maximum amount €1,000

Aid for refugees or displaced persons

Six places are offered with financial aid of **up to 50%** of the tuition fee for the academic year for refugees or displaced persons affected by an international conflict, to enable them to pursue bachelor degree studies at any of its three Schools. If you are the beneficiary of this grant, a renewal assessment will be carried out based on your personal situation in the subsequent years to determine renewal eligibility.

Public aid

Scholarships from the Ministry of Education and Vocational Training (MEFP)

Each academic year, the Ministry of Education and Vocational Training announces general and mobility scholarships, among others, for bachelor and master degree students.

Scholarships from the General Agency for University and Research Grants (AGAUR)

AGAUR is a body under the Commissioner for Universities and Research of the Department of Innovation, Universities, and Enterprise that manages various types of university and research grants. Each academic year, it promotes general financial aid for bachelor, graduate, and PhD students. It also offers scholarships for specific groups and loans for university students.

Santander-URL scholarships

In addition to the scholarships and financial aid offered by Blanquerna, students can also apply for other scholarships and economic support options, such as those provided by Banco Santander (available through their dedicated URL).
